- Doctoral Degree in health or medical related field is required
- Graduate of an accredited PA program with current NCCPA certification is desired but not required
- Demonstration of experience working with and ongoing commitment to rural and/or underserved communities and delivery of care in challenging environments
- Evidence of leadership within healthcare and/or medical education
- Experience with international and/or domestic medical mission trips
- Excellent organizational skills in the area of curriculum delivery and service trip implementation
- A commitment to working with a diverse population of students is essential; demonstrated experience in this area is preferred
- All applicants must express a personal commitment to Jesus Christ and express their Christian
  testimony in a local church. In addition, professors agree to live in agreement with the
  Community Lifestyle Statement and affirm the theological commitments expressed in the
  Statement of Faith.
- Candidates must have legal authority to permanently work in the U.S.

### **Salary and Rank**

Appointment at the Assistant Professor level is anticipated, though candidates with significant teaching experience at previous institutions may be considered for appointment at the rank of Associate Professor. Salary and benefits are competitive with comparable institutions.
